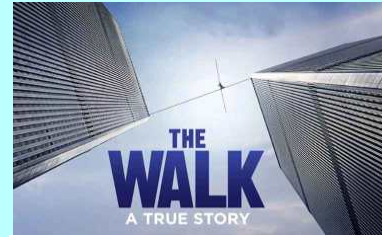

On the darkest day in history, a glimmer of hope sparks between two strangers, and thus begins A Special Day.

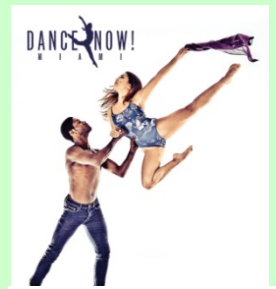
